Important Information

- Results of the 2024 Singapore-Cambridge General Certificate of Education Ordinary Level (GCE O-Level) examination will be released on **Friday, 10 January 2025**.
- 2024 Sec 4 students collecting their results in school are allowed into the school from **1.45pm onwards** in their **full school uniform** (school blouse, pinafore and shoes). Students are to be appropriately attired and groomed (hair should not be coloured and long hair to be neatly tied), according to the school rules and guidelines.
- Parents / guardians will be allowed to enter the school. If driving, please park at the **public carparks outside the school**.

Joint Admissions Exercise (JAE)

- Students may appoint a proxy to collect a physical copy of their O-Level results on their behalf, on Friday 10 January (3.30pm to 5pm) and Monday, 13 January (9am to 4pm). Students' proxies are to produce relevant documents for the school's verification:
 - a. Completed proxy form (available at www.moe.gov.sg/jaeproxy)
 - b. Parents' / guardian's NRIC / passport
 - c. Student's NRIC / Birth Certificate / passport
 - d. Proxy' NRIC



Joint Admissions Exercise (JAE)

From 3pm on Friday 10 January, students will receive an email (via their registered emails) from MOE to inform of JAE eligibility. Students should check their inbox, junk or spam folder.

If student is eligible, the same email will include Form A which contains gross aggregate scores for different institution types and the eligible courses they can apply.

All students eligible for JAE may also download a copy of Form A from the JAE-Internet System (JAE-IS) during the application period.



Joint Admissions Exercise (JAE)

- JAE application
 - From 4 pm on 10 Jan 2025 (Fri) to 4 pm on 15 Jan 2025 (Wed)
 - Submission of course choices through the JAE-IS at <https://www.moe.gov.sg/jae> using students' Singpass
- Posting Results – 4 Feb 2025 (Tue)
 - via SMS through mobile phone number provided during application
 - JAE-IS, to be accessed using students' Singpass
- Reporting to JC/MI (for students posted to JC/MI only) – 5 Feb 2025 (Wed)
- Students posted to polytechnics will receive a letter from their respective institutions on the enrolment details by end Feb 2025
 - please ensure that the mailing address stated in the online application is valid



Joint Admissions Exercise (JAE)

- Please consider all 12 choices wisely. Choices should be listed in the order of preference.
- Refer to Courses Offered in 2025 JAE (online). Note that the course aggregate scores may vary from previous years and are meant to serve as a guide, not actual admission scores.



Joint Admissions Exercise (JAE)

- JCs and MI offer a variety of subjects and different subject combinations. They may also set their own school-based criteria for subjects offered, based on professional and student-centric considerations. Posting to an Arts, Science or Commerce course does not guarantee that students will be able to offer their preferred subject combinations.
- Students should check the website of the respective JCs and MI for more details on the subject combinations offered in the Arts, Science and Commerce courses and school-based criteria for subjects offered.
- Beyond academic requirements, students should note that some polytechnic / ITE courses may require students to meet non-academic requirements. Students are advised to research these requirements to make informed choices.

Students who had **accepted offers through DSA / EAE** will **not be eligible** to participate in JAE.

Joint Admissions Exercise (JAE)

- Upon successful submission of JAE application, a verification slip will be sent to the email address provided in the JAE-IS. Students should check their inbox, junk or spam folder. If they do not receive the verification slip email, they should re-login to JAE-IS to check on their application status
- For students who are unable to submit their application via the JAE-IS, they can submit a request for assistance using the online **JAE Request Form** during the JAE application period

Maximise your chances and utilise all 12 choices to improve your chances of getting into your school / course of your choice.

PASSION

First 4 choices (1st to 4th):

Choose what you're passionate about, even if you don't meet the past year's JAE L1R5 / ELR2B2 range.

PRACTICAL

Next 4 choices (5th to 8th):

Put courses which you're interested in and for which your net aggregate score is close to the past year's JAE L1R5 / ELR2B2 range.

PRUDENCE

Last 4 choices (9th to 12th):

Include less competitive courses that you clearly qualify for.
e.g., choose courses with JAE L1R5 / ELR2B2 range well above your aggregate score.
